

## **Emergency Codes**

<b><u>Code Red:</u></b> Fire/Smoke Situation - R.A.C.E. – Rescue Alert Confine Extinguish
<b>Code Orange:</b> Level One - External Mass Casualty Incident has been reported or occurred. Number casualties probable or received from 1-10.
<b>Code Orange: Level Two</b> - External Mass Casualty Incident has been reported or occurred. Number of casualty probable or received greater than 10.
Code Orange: All Clear - Initiation stage terminated
Code Green: Patient Elopement
<b><u>Code Yellow:</u></b> Severe Weather threatening area.
Code Yellow-All Clear: Severe weather has passed
Code White: (Location) - Medical Emergency for Adult Visitor
Code White PALS: - Medical Emergency for child, PALS cart required
Code Black: Water/Electricity/Telephones/Medical Gas/Utilities Failure
Code Silver: Active Shooter situation
<b><u>STAT</u></b> : Emergency situation exists and assistance is needed immediately.
Code CAT: Critical Assessment Team
Code 99: Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Team
Code 99 AED: Cardiac/Respiratory Arrest w/Automatic External Defibrillator
Code 99 PALS: Pediatric Cardiac/Respiratory Arrest
Code Telfair: Infant Abduction from Telfair Unit
Code Adam: Pediatric/Adolescent Abduction
<u>Code B.E.R.T:</u> (Behavioral Emergent Response Team) – request for assistance for members trained in non-violent crisis intervention techniques to de-escalate a situation.
Code <b>DEDT</b> Lovel II. Debevienel Encencency Destructor Team as such as such

<u>Code B.E.R.T. Level II:</u> Behavioral Emergency Response Team request requiring local law enforcement assistance.
